

Pre-Course Information.

Thank you for choosing Click-2-Heel for your training. You have taken the first step towards owning a well-mannered, responsive and loyal dog, who will be a friend for life! Through our positive reinforcement training methods you will be able to get the best from your dog, without the need for harsh handling and lots of corrections. Your dog will love training, and will want to please his handler!

What to Bring:

- A hungry dog – don't feed your dog before coming to classes. The food he will receive during training will replace a feed, so adjust your feeding times so he's ready for a meal during class
- A meal's worth of food – a mixture of kibble and something like chicken breast is ideal. Something he will like, and can be broken up into bite sized bits! Commercial treats are normally not suitable as they are too rich to be fed in such volumes although small amount of good quality treats will be okay to add to the mix
- A clicker, and a treat pouch. Both can be bought from us at the class, but if you have your own, please bring them along.
- A toy - something soft and fleecy that enables you to play an interactive game. No balls, nothing that squeaks!
